# SUNDAY, MARCH 31, 2019 DONNIE RANKIN



Donnie Rankin first took an interest in the theatre organ at the tender age of three when he first heard the sounds of the Mighty Wurlitzer at the Civic Theatre in Akron, Ohio. Following that initial introduction to the King of Instruments, he frequently played on his greatgrandfather's home organ. In 2000 Donnie acquired an instrument and began taking formal lessons. Classical piano training followed in 2005, and his budding talent quickly blossomed into first rate musicianship. Since then, Donnie has won several organ competitions and awards, including being named the Overall Winner of the American Theatre Organ Society's Young Theatre Organist Competition in 2007.

Donnie began studying with noted organist Jelani Eddington in September 2007. Since that time, Donnie has performed for theatre organ audiences around the world. He resides in Ravenna, Ohio, and is a staff organist at the Civic Theatre in nearby Akron – the very same organ Donnie first beard when he was three years old.

### **Taylor's Pride & Joy**

My virtual organ began life in the State Theatre in Toledo Ohio. The 3/11 Marr Colton was installed in 1927 and played until April 17, 1971 when the great Kay McAbee played the final concert at the theatre to a packed house. I have a copy of that final concert and listen to it often.

Rick Shindell maintained and played that instrument for several years in the theatre. He made a record on the Concert Recording label just before the organ was removed. Rick was a regular visitor

to Fay and Bob Wheelers in Lockport.

After leaving Ohio, the organ went to Wisconsin where it was "updated" with more stops and many of the ranks of pipes were replaced and several were added. The ornamentation was removed, it was painted off white. Several years later, the organ was given back to the Toledo Organ Club and parts of the organ were installed in the Collingwood Arts Center. It was used for about a year and then removed. The console was listed for sale in 2010 and I purchased it to replace the 2 manual Marr Colton that I had installed in my basement. I began working on it, installing the Artisan Micro Midi System as the relay and used their sound engine to start with. With the release of the Hauptwerk sound engine, I decided to upgrade and use their samples. The sound system has 10 channels that use 6 Behringer 60 watt speakers and 2 sub woofers. I kept four of the original stop tabs from the 3 manual, four from the 2 manual and then ordered new stop tabs from Arndt Organ Supply.

I was fortunate to meet Rick several years back and he has provided me with many pictures of the organ in the State Theatre as well as a video of him at the console. I hope (when I retire) to start the console restoration and find the ornamentation to have it look as it did when it was in the theatre.

Special note: Taylor's virtual theater pipe organ also was a featured article in an issue of the ATOS journal.
