Work Started on the Barton!

On July 1st, Judy Matarelli, our representative at the ATOS convention in New York, had informed me that we were awarded an ATOS grant in the sum of \$4600.00 for the repairs needed to the Barton to make it ready for the 2022 Chicago convention. "WOW" is all I had to say! Here are the projects:



Main Vox Regulator rebuild (completed)

Xylophone equalizer rebuild (completed)

Main Tibia Chest rebuild

Concert Flute Chest rebuild

Swell Shades upper main

Swell Shades lower main

Lobby organ repairs

As you can see most all the work is in the main chambers. After all this is completed, the toy counter will need to be rebuilt. We are going to update the Peterson computer program so we can have orchestra bells, a reiterating xylophone and marimba. New stop tabs are being engraved to replace the tape covered ones. New toe pistons will be waiting to go in to operate some of the sound effects. The goal here is to have the organ 100% working. I don't know if that has ever happened. If it's in the chambers then it needs to work. Our pride and joy will be the lobby organ playing again as patrons enter the Rialto.

Much will be going on the rest of the year and into 2020.

Jared Goldinger is 19 years old and lives in Massillon, Ohio. Regularly, he plays at the Canton Palace Theatre on the 3/11 Kilgen Wonder Organ, mostly before movies, and has played in numerous locations, including the Akron Civic Theatre, and the Connor Palace Theatre in Cleveland. Jared has been playing the Classical organ for almost 4 years, and the theatre pipe organ for 3 years. However, he has been studying piano for 12 years. He became interested in the pipe organ after attending a silent film "Gold Rush" by Charlie Chaplin. Jared is coached by Mark Thewes for his classical organ studying, and by Jelani Eddington for theatre organ, with help from Jay Spencer, another theatre


organist from Canton. Jared has attended the 2016 ATOS Annual Convention in Cleveland, Ohio as a winner of the George Wright Memorial Fellowship, and had helped tuned the Wurlitzer at the Akron Civic Theatre before the convention. He also attends the annual ATOS Summer Youth Adventure, for further instruction to refine his technique and skill. As a result, Jared was a finalist in 2019 for the Young Theatre Organist's Competition, which was held during the Annual Convention in Rochester, New York. Outside of the theatre organ world, Jared is the staff organist for Faith Lutheran Church in Massillon, where he has been organist since November of 2018. Jared enjoys creating music, whether it be arrangements, or compositions created digitally. Jared graduated from Jackson High School in May of 2018, and had attended the Jackson School of the Arts, a school with curriculum centered around any and all art forms,

including choir, band, dance, and theatre. He will be attending Aerotek Flight School to obtain his pilot's license, and go on to become a private or commercial pilot.



Nathan Hall is 19 years old, and an aspiring musician who plans on pursuing vocal performance and composition. He has been extremely passionate about music since he was young, and has been excited to perform anywhere in anyway that he can. Nate graduated from Jackson High School in Massillon, Ohio in 2018, and also attended the Jackson School for the Arts, where he participated in Theatre, Choir, and the show choir through high school. He also sings with the Jackson Jazz Band throughout the year. Being on stage is nothing new to him with these

David Gray, a young Scottish piano and organ prodigy and student of the London Royal Academy of Music, had his first opportunity to play a theatre organ at age 13. Subsequently, a local teacher "took him under his wing", coaching him in the art of theatre organ. In 2005 David won the international "American Theatre Organ Society Young Theatre Organist of the Year" competition in Los Angeles. He has since played concerts throughout the UK, Australia, New Zealand, USA and Switzerland. David graduated with honors with a Bachelor of Music (Performance) degree at the Royal Academy of Music in London. Walt Strony, one of the world's most highly sought after theatre organists, commented on David performance: "As I write this, David Gray just finished playing an amazing piano solo. Today we are witnessing the birth of a new concert artist – one with talent, technique and a quiet unassuming personality that will win many supporters. In an organ world filled with mediocrity and, in my opinion, too many 'formula' players who are not at all original, it's such a joy and privilege to know that the future of the art form is secure." This young man has a unique style all his own and is a refreshing joy to listen to.


